### ORDER

Complaint Petitioner, Adv. K.M. Krishnakumar, represented before the Commission that no reply was received on his application submitted before the Respondent. He requested the Commission to take legal action against the Respondent officer for his failure to furnish information and direct the Respondent to furnish the information requested for.

2. In his application submitted before the Respondent, the Complaint Petitioner sought the following information:

- i. What is the reason for non-conducting of SSLC examinations on Fridays in Kerala.
- ii. What is the number of the relevant order which prevents conduct of SSSLC examinations on Fridays.
- iii. Whether the scheme introduced for conducting SSLC examinations is intended for the convenience of the students in Kerala so on numbering to 6 items.

3. In the report furnished before the Commission by the Respondent, it was stated that the information sought by the Complaint Petitioner was furnished to him on 02/5/2017 vide letter CGL(1)/14837/2017/CGE. A copy of the reply furnished to the Complaint Petitioner was also forwarded to the Commission.

4. The Commission also finds that a copy of the report along with copy of the reply already sent has been forwarded to the Complaint Petitioner by the present SPIO on 14/01/2020.

5. In view of the above, the Commission does not find any merit in this complaint petition and hence the same is disposed of accordingly on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2020.
